# <u>IMPORTANT – EXHIBITORS' MEETING</u>

Monday, June 3<sup>rd</sup> at 9:30 a.m. on the covered arena concourse near the in-gate.

To ensure that the show runs smoothly and that everyone is aware of any modifications or changes, we request that all handlers and owners attend the Monday morning meeting, at which time any questions or concerns will be addressed and new procedures clarified.

# **JUDGING CHANGES**

The 2013 Egyptian Event will be judged in its entirety by **a panel of FIVE rotational judges**. Three will be judging halter, one will be monitoring for rule violations, and one will be sitting out at any given time. **The three EBC judges will also be drawn from this panel**. A single judge will continue to judge the performance classes.

# JUDGING CATEGORIES AND CLASS CONDUCT

Classes using the Modified European Judging System will include a **seventh category**: "Balance, Substance and Quality at the Walk." A full description of this category is included on our website in the Members Only section under Standard of Excellence Preview, Balance, Substance and Quality at the Walk.

PLEASE NOTE: classes using the Modified European Judging System will be conducted in a slightly different manner to accommodate the new category referenced above. **Check the Prize List and attend the Exhibitors Meeting for Owners and Handlers**, on Monday June 3<sup>rd</sup> at 9.30 a.m. at the in-gate.

In ALL halter classes, horses will enter the ring in age order, from oldest to youngest and will be judged IN THE ORDER THEY ENTER THE RING.

# TIES

Any TIES in classes using the Modified European Judging System will be broken by category scores in the following order. In the event there is still a tie, the Call Judge's card will prevail.

Type

Balance, Quality and Substance at the Walk

Head

Neck and Shoulder

Body and Topline

Leas and Hooves

Movement

# CHAMPIONSHIPS - JUDGING

The **four Saturday night championship classes**, Junior Champion Fillies and Colts, and Senior Champion Mares and Stallions **will be judged by ALL FIVE judges**.

All judges for Saturday night championship classes will assign points as follows. Three first places will automatically win Gold Champion, and in the event of a Tie the Call Judge's card will determine the placings.

 $1^{\text{st}}$  = 3 points  $2^{\text{nd}}$  = 2 points  $3^{\text{rd}}$  = 1 point  $4^{\text{th}}$  = 0 points

Saturday Night Championships: **any horse entering the ring, regardless of previous placing is eligible to win** Gold, Silver or Bronze Championships. Horses will enter in strictly age order, oldest to youngest.

# LIBERTY CLASS ENTRY DEADLINE

Please note: Deadline for entry is **MONDAY**, **JUNE 3<sup>RD</sup> BY 4.00 p.m.** There are no exceptions to this deadline.

# STALL ASSIGNMENTS

No stall assignments will be given prior to arrival at the Kentucky Horse Park, with the exception of those occupying the same number and location of stalls as in 2012, and who meet the March 15 deadline. This is done in an effort to maintain flexibility and better accommodate changes in stall requests, which inevitably occur.

Attached to your Exhibitor package will be "Conduct for General Stabling and Parties". Please read carefully and abide by these rules in order to make the Egyptian Event pleasurable for all exhibitors and attendees.
